Opportunities for Guides

Patrol Leaders and Seconders

- Open to any guide who wishes to hold a leadership role in their unit.
- Duties include planning and running games and activities, helping with unit jobs.

Rainbow Helper

- You will be part of the Leadership Team supporting Rainbows.
- Help support girls to access the programme.
- Run games and activities
- Attend trips, events, and sleepovers

Brownie Helper

- You will be part of the Leadership Team supporting Brownies.
- Help support girls to access the programme.
- Run games and activities
- Attend trips, events, and sleepovers

 - You'll be part of a team of volunteers who plan and run weekly meetings
 - Go to weekly unit meetings and help girls to do activities from the Girlguiding programme
 - Plan and run fun activities and games, adapting them to the needs of the whole group
 - Attend and help organise exciting events, from day-long trips to sleepovers or whole weekends of fun
 - Be a role model for younger girls.

- You'll run fun activities which have been developed in partnership with girls and experts.

Opportunities for 18 and over

- Unit Leader with Rainbows, Brownies, Guides and/or Rangers
 - As a unit or assistant leader or leader-in-training you'll help a team of volunteers to plan and run meetings, and deliver activities.
 - You can complete our Leader development programme.
 - Help plan and deliver activities which are based on our Girlguiding programme.
- Unit Helper with Rainbows, Brownies, Guides and/or Rangers
 - As a unit helper you'll give girls opportunities for fun, friendship, challenge and adventure!
 - You'll usually work with other volunteers to help run fantastic activities, whilst keeping our members safe.
 - Unit helpers assist the unit leadership team in running units.
 - You'll be part of a leadership team that includes a mixture of leadership roles.
